Defibrillator – Information on the proposed defibrillator would be collated for the Faculty and submitted in the New Year.

Memorial Bench in Portland Road – The Jacob Kaye Memorial Bench would have some maintenance work completed to it in the spring when the weather had improved. Councillor Peter Booth would make the necessary arrangements.
