Minutes - The minutes of the meeting held on 2 July 2019 were agreed as a correct record.

## Parish Council/Village Matters:

Emergency Planning – A template for a village Emergency Plan had been received from the County Council and a draft plan would be submitted to a future meeting. Emergency bags would also be delivered to all houses in the village.

Death of a National Figure - A Book of Condolence had been purchased by the Clerk.

Defibrillator – Information would be sent to Councillors with regard to the defibrillator purchased by Bloxham Parish Council and Councillors would visit the units in Bloxham and Adderbury to gather further details.

Highways – Repairs which were required to potholes should be reported to the County Council's Fix My Street web site. <a href="https://fixmystreet.oxfordshire.gov.uk/">https://fixmystreet.oxfordshire.gov.uk/</a> Work to the A361 had been started by Oxfordshire County Council and the road would be closed during off-peak hours. There were also a number of other highways issues which would be reported to the County Council, including a request for a new 'Welcome to Milcombe' sign on the road from Hook Norton.

Residents were reminded that trees/bushes/hedges should not be causing an obstruction because they were overhanging a boundary onto a footpath or road. Play Area – Councillor Pete Booth was thanked for the adaptions he had made to the swings in the play area to stop the birds from messing on the seats. The Clerk had been in contact with Cherwell District Council and Sanctuary Housing and there were currently no timescales for when the funds for the play area project would be completed.
